### Styrofoam

Place clean, white Styrofoam (no packing peanuts or food/drink containers) in clear bags. Contact Thermal Foams at (716) 874-6474 to schedule a drop-off.

### Plastic Bags

New York State requires retail locations larger than 10,000 square feet to have drop off boxes for plastic bags.

### Large Bulky Items

Always contact your property manager to find out the best way to dispose of larger unwanted items.
