WHY SHOULD YOU RECYCLE?

- RECYCLING HELPS THE ENVIRONMENT
- IT'S THE LAW!

WHAT CAN YOU DO?

- TALK TO YOUR BUILDING MANAGER TO FIND OUT WHERE YOUR RECYCLING TOTES ARE LOCATED
- COLLECT RECYCLABLES IN THE PROVIDED BAG; BRING TO THE RECYCLING STATION; EMPTY AND USE AGAIN!
- THAT'S IT!

TIPS!

- Organize a "Free Stuff" bin in your apartment building
- Take Plastic Bags back to the store
- Rinse containers before putting into the tote
- Donate clothes & old furniture
- Use Buffalo Yard Waste and Food Scrap drop off locations

WHAT'S RECYCLABLE?

- PLASTIC BOTTLES
- METAL CANS
- MIXED PAPER / CARDBOARD
- GLASS CONTAINERS

WHAT'S NOT RECYCLABLE?

What doesn't belong in recycling is as important as what does! The top 4 contaminants in the City of Buffalo are:

1. PLASTIC WRAP & PLASTIC BAGS
2. YARD WASTE
3. FOOD
4. CLOTHING
